This agreement between the Ministry of Education and the National Film Board has recently come to an end. In order to provide all teachers and students with uninterrupted service to complete their school year, the NFB will be maintaining the service for Ontario school boards until June 30, 2016, after which school boards will be responsible for their own purchases.
